Major Accomplishments

- 1. Support for EIA Application: Several UOAC members served on the NILOA Excellence in Assessment designation application committee. This was NMSU's first submission of the EIA application. We are still awaiting the results of the application. The UOAC thanks David Smith, Director of the Office of Assessment, for his leadership in compiling and submitting the application.
- 2. Monthly meetings: The UOAC served effectively in an advisory capacity to the Director of Assessment.
- 3. Excellence in Assessment Award: Two members of the UOAC reviewed finalists for OAC-CAO's annual Excellence in Assessment Award presented at Spring Convocation to a co-curricular, administrative, or operations unit based on quality of their submitted assessment reports.
- 4. Assessment Consultation: Members of the UOAC participated in multiple meetings with Linda Suskie on May 17, 2017. The Office of Assessment invited Ms. Suskie to campus for a workshop and consulting. The consulting meetings resulted in a 4-page report with observations about assessment at NMSU and suggestions for improvement.

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
